



How to trick out your TOOL STOOL

My tool stool is designed to hold a load of tools. For interior storage, you've got a top tool tray (accessible beneath a hinged top), and two drawers. Outside, there's storage space on the stool's ends and back. On these outside surfaces, it makes sense to store the tools you are likely to use the most. You'll need to make some special holders for your outer tools. This isn't difficult to do if you make use of commonly available materials: scrap wood, magnets, dowels, T-nuts, and a spring clip or two.
